



# CONNECTING TO A WIRELESS NETWORK

If you are not able to connect by opening your browser, the following settings may need to be changed in order to facilitate wireless network access. **Please Note:** Each laptop is configured differently and changing the settings below will not guarantee you will be able to connect to a wireless network. These are general settings that need to be configured for most laptops to access a wireless environment.

## Windows Users

1. Make sure you have the SSID set to "MTN-DSI":
  - a. Move the mouse over the Wireless Connection Icon on the bottom right corner of the screen. It should show: "Wireless Network Connection (mtnndsi)."
  - b. If it is not connected: right click on the Wireless Connection Icon and select "View Available Wireless Networks." Choose "mtnndsi."
  - c. Check the "Allow me to Connect" box, then click "Connect."
2. Check your Internet Settings:
  - a. Go to Start > Settings > Control Panel > Internet Options > under the "connections" tab.
  - b. Make sure "Never dial a connection" is selected in the top box.
  - c. Click on the LAN SETTINGS buttons at the bottom.
  - d. Make sure "Automatically detect settings" is checked at the top.
  - e. Make sure "Use a Proxy Server" is not checked.
3. Make sure any Firewall software you may have is disabled:
  - a. Look in the system tray (next to clock on task bar for running firewall/Internet security programs).
4. Make sure your wireless card's encryption is disabled:
  - a. Right click on the Wireless Connection Icon and select "Status." Click on "Properties" and choose the "Wireless Networks" tab. Highlight "mtnndsi." and click "Configure."
  - b. Under the "Association" tab, all boxes should not be un-checked.
5. Make sure pop-up blocker software is disabled:
  - a. Look in the system tray for pop up blocker programs.
6. Make sure DHCP is enabled on the wireless card:
  - a. Go to Start > Settings > Control Panel > Network Connections.
  - b. Right click the Wireless Network Connection > Properties.
  - c. Double-Click Internet Protocol (TCP/IP).
  - d. Make sure "Obtain an IP address automatically" is selected.
  - e. Make sure "Obtain DNS server address automatically" is selected.
  - f. Click OK, click Ok.
7. Make sure SSID is turned off:
  - a. Go to Start > Settings > Control Panel > Network Connections.
  - b. Right click the Wireless Network Connection > Properties.
  - c. Click on Wireless networks tab
  - d. Click CONFIGURE.
  - e. Make sure all boxes are not checked.
8. If you are running Norton Anti-Virus, disable script blocking:
  - a. Go to Norton Anti-virus Properties.
  - b. Find the "Script Blocking" box. Be sure it is not checked.

## Microsoft Outlook Users:

You may have to change the outgoing SMTP server address to 172.31.0.2 in order to send your messages. Please remember to make a note of your original address, as these will need to be reset to your original configuration when you get home.

## Macintosh Users

1. Turn "Airport" on in the "Internet Connect" application.
  - a. From Menu Bar select Go > Applications.
  - b. Scroll down the list of applications and open "Internet Connect".
  - c. Click "Turn on Airport" button.
  - d. Using the drop down arrow, open the network menu and select "MTN-DSI"
  - e. The blue bar should now show the signal strength of the "MTN-DSI" network.
  - f. Open the Internet Browser and see if you are redirected to login page.
2. If "MTN-DSI" network does not appear in the network menu list:
  - a. Go to the "Apple Menu" from the Menu Bar and open "System Preferences."
  - b. Open "Network" preferences.
  - c. The following settings should be marked:  
LOCATION: set to "automatic"  
SHOW: set to "Airport"  
TCP/IP:  
CONFIGURE > set to "Using DHCP"  
AIRPORT TAB: select "Join network with best signal"  
(or temporarily use "Join a specific network" to select or create the "MTN-DSI" network).
  - d. Click "Apply Now" button.
  - e. Restart laptop for settings to take effect.

**New Password:** The system will ask you to enter a new password. Use this new password for all future log ins.







# Spotlight on Aruba



## HISTORY

Aruba has a fascinating history, one that has been colored by warring European colonizers, a boom-and-bust economy and the creation of a new language. The unique language, Papiamentu, is something of which Arubans are especially proud; it is a unique combination of Portuguese, Spanish, Dutch, English, African and Indian words. It is spoken only on the Dutch "ABC" islands of Aruba, Bonaire and Curaçao.

Alonso de Ojeda claimed Aruba for the Spanish Crown in 1499. In 1634, near the culmination of their 80-year war with Spain, the Dutch took over the island. Aruba is part of the Dutch Commonwealth and had its "Status Aparte" in 1986.

Gold was discovered on the island in 1824 and mined successfully until 1913. As the yield turned meager and mining became unprofitable, the aloe plant became the primary agricultural crop. The island soon became the world's leading aloe producer.

In 1929, the Lago Oil and Transport Company, a subsidiary of Standard Oil of New Jersey, built a large refinery at the southeastern

tip of the island. The Lago refinery became the largest in the world, assuring Aruba its place as one of the most prosperous islands in the Caribbean. The refinery has been owned and managed by Valero Energy Corp. since 2004.

By 1959, tourists discovered Aruba's perfect beaches and incredibly clear aqua-blue waters, ensuring prosperity for the foreseeable future.





# Spotlight on Puerto Vallarta



## HISTORY

The history of Puerto Vallarta is different from that of many Mexican cities which have a past dating back thousands of years to the Olmecs, Toltecs and Maya. Puerto Vallarta, was discovered only a few centuries ago, in 1541, by Don Pedro de Alvarado. The port was practically forgotten for the next 300 years.

The bay was developed as a port to transport silver from the nearby mines. At that time, the village was known as Puerto de Peñas, and there were only about 1,500 inhabitants. In the early 1900's, it was designated a municipality and received the name "Puerto Vallarta." Puerto Vallarta remained a quiet fishing village for the next 30 years.

In the 1950's, the possibilities of turning the area into a weekend resort for nearby Guadalajara stirred some interest. A few writers described the natural beauty and serenity of the town, and the American director John Houston visited the area.

International attention was first drawn to Puerto Vallarta by the scandal surrounding Houston's film, *Night of the Iguana*, which was filmed in nearby Mismaloya. The star, Richard Burton, was accompanied by Elizabeth Taylor, who was still married to Eddie Fisher. The reporters who had come to cover the story were enthralled by the

unspoiled, quaint area. When they returned home, the word was out.

Recently, Puerto Vallarta has experienced astronomical growth. Several five-star hotel and condominium complexes have been completed and more are being constructed. There's also an 18-hole golf course and a marina with a capacity of 300 boats. Today, this part of Puerto Vallarta is truly a world-class resort community with old world charm.

## LOCAL FLAVORS

Intricate hand-embroidered designs decorate traditional style Mexican blouses and dresses found in Puerto Vallarta. Puerto Vallartans pair the hand-woven and hand-embroidered styles with lovely sterling silver from the Taxco region for an authentic Mexican look.

The ship docks about three miles north of downtown Puerto Vallarta, next to Playa Del Oro beach.

# Spotlight on Acapulco



## HISTORY

Acapulco was originally a part of the Aztec empire, though no major ruins remain in the area. After the arrival of Hernán Cortés and his troops in 1530, it was quickly established as a busy ship-building center and an important naval base for Spain. By the late 1500's, the city was a major port of call for treasure ships laden with silk, spices, porcelain and ivory from the Orient as well as gold and silver from South America.

The imported goods were subsequently transported over land by mule to Mexico City and then to Veracruz, where the expensive cargo was then shipped to Spain. When word of these opulent shiploads reached Europe, Dutch and English pirates began raiding and plundering the Spanish galleons. For protection against these buccaneers, the Fuerte de San Diego was built. The star-shaped fort, which stands just outside the town center, replaced an earlier structure destroyed by an earthquake in 1776. The lucrative trade with the Far East ceased when Spain was pushed out of Mexico.

to a remote fishing village, and remained so until 1922, when a road linked it with Mexico City. Ten years later, people began making the trip from Mexico City to Acapulco for vacation. The first hotel opened in 1934, but the real boom started after World War II. Acapulco's natural beauty soon attracted the attention of international jet-setters, giving the town, now the heart of the Mexican Riviera, its world-renowned cosmopolitan air.
